

Muchedumbre

Heriberto Sarmiento wanders through the mountains of Jordán, his town, seeking to rebuild the crucifixion of his aunt Paulina in 1956. She was a peasant leader who was murdered by a paramilitary group during the Violence of the 50s in Colombia. The impossibility of reconstructing the assassination is disrupted when the director of the unreleased film Return to Nothingness, a western about bandits and thugs filmed in Jordán in the 90s, returns to the town to screen it for the first time. The screening triggers a collective exorcism, and the survivors, bewildered by the images, decide to break the silence and recreate the crucifixion of Doña Paulina.





Oasis

In El Oasis, a Rarámuri settlement in Chihuahua, Amalia, Paula, Liliana, and Paloma, spanning three generations, grapple with their dual identities. They navigate between tradition and globalization, forging a protective bond against various forms of violence. Determined to break free from limbo, they unite to establish a community governed by Rarámuri women's own rules in the city. Oasis is a tale of sisterhood and resistance.

Filmika Galaika was founded in 2009 with the intention of promoting the production of films with a clear authorial and independent vocation. It is a reference in Galician cinematography for the production of films such as Eles transportan a morte/They Carry Death (Helena Girón and Samuel M. Delgado, 2021) Longa Noite (Eloy Enciso, 2019) or Vikingland (Xurxo Chirro, 2011). Films produced by Filmika Galaika have received jury recognition at festivals such as San Sebastian, Venice, Locarno IFF or Mar del Plata, among others. Its productions have also been exhibited in museums and art centers such as MOMA, Museo Reina Sofía, Harvard Film Archive or Flaherty Film Seminar.

The Mountain on My Wall is part of the diary of a journey-shipwreck. What begins as a search for the experience of emptiness in the Nepalese Himalayas, unpredictably, culminates in its antipodes, in the Chilean desert of Atacama, where emptiness fills everything, plunging us into a new beginning. That journey is revisited ten years later from Galicia through the personal archive, made up mainly of Super-8 films, travel notebooks, photographs and sound materials.

Dancing with Death narrates the convergence of three stories: the history of flamenco in Spain and in exile, the history of Spanish cinema, and the history of Spain during Franco's dictatorship. By exploring the different experiences of flamenco in inland Spain and in exile, the documentary attempts to trace the visual representation of a certain Spanish identity and culture - one that was influenced and manipulated from both perspectives. Dancing with Death delves into something that concerns us all: the struggle for the elements that define and identify us.
